#### 1. Integrated education approach

- formal education process
- non-formal education process
- informell education process

#### 2. Integrated learning approach

- intellectual level (life-long learning) « learn to know and to act »
- socialcultural level « learn to live together and learn to participate »
- institutional level (the institutions have to adapt themselves to the people not the other way round)
