

On this occasion, the activities proposed at the Ciaf of Castelfiorentino have had as their main theme the sharing, specifically the sharing of different points of view during the readings and the sharing of small and big commitments by the young people present, through the construction of a special tree. We have linked our activities to the figure of Bruno Munari. As for the readings, we have prepared a kind of living room made of cushions; one of our operators has introduced with an animated narration the story of "Little Red Riding Hood", to move on to revisitations (or better, other points of view) proposed by Munari, as "Little Yellow Riding Hood", "Little Green Riding Hood", "Little White Riding Hood", "Little Blue Riding Hood". The children present have read each of the books in turn; at the end of the reading, space was given to a confrontation that brought out emotions and thoughts about it.

Another of the activities concerned the construction of the "Munari Tree", providing the floor of the entire structure; on each branch a small message or a commitment was left. A more playful moment has seen protagonists dances in group coming from all over Europe, belonging to that tradition that is lost over the centuries. Before the start of the activities, our operators left the children an unstructured break, leaving room for free play to lower stress levels after a full day at school.
